**DECISION**

Upon an application dated 12<sup>th</sup> April 2019 by Mr Eamon Doherty ("the applicant") under Article 90A of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Northern Ireland) Order 1995 ("the 1995 Act").

1. The applicant made a complaint alleging a breach of union rules relating to the election of a person to office.
2. The application is here by struck out on the Order of the Certification Officer pursuant to Article 70ZA of the Industrial Relations Order (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 as amended by The Employment Relations Order 2004.
3. The reason for strike out is, that based on present evidence and the submissions to date by the parties, the Certification Officer cannot find any case for a breach of the rules of the union which has a reasonable prospect of success under the Certification Officer's jurisdiction.
